



All Saints' School – Boonah Enrolment Policy

All Saints' School is a Parish school established primarily to provide Catholic Education for the children of families of All Saints' Parish. To provide Catholic education, children who are not part of the Parish Community may be enrolled. These students would be expected to benefit from and/or contribute to the Catholic ethos of the school.

Regulations

- For enrolment in Prep children must have turned 4 years on or by 30 June prior to the year of commencement.
- New enrolments must include:
 - Photocopy of Birth Certificate.
 - Baptismal Certificate (if applicable).
 - Fully completed Application for Enrolment form.
 - Photocopy of most recent school report (if applicable)
- Enrolment from another school must be accompanied by Transfer Notice.

Procedure

- Application for enrolment is made by completing an Application for Enrolment and lodging it and the required documentation with the school.
- The Principal will normally interview parents who lodge an Application for Enrolment and advise if the enrolment is accepted.
- In the case of children with special needs the Brisbane Catholic Education Enrolment Application and Support Procedures will be followed.
- Applications for enrolment in Prep are expected by July of the preceding year.

Criteria

All applications for enrolment will be considered within the bounds of the Brisbane Catholic Education Policy and the following criteria:

- Siblings of students already enrolled.
- Members of the local Catholic Community.
- Non-Catholic families who value the Catholic ethos and agree to support it.
